YEARLING SALE AT LE LION D'ANGERS A NEW OPPOTUNITY FOR BREEDERS

Thanks to the dynamism of the team of Alain Peltier, President of the Lion d'Angers racecourse, the sale took place in the best conditions.

Out of 92 yearlings presented, 51 were sold, of which 2 in private sales, representing 55,43% for a total of $\textcircled{276}{500}$ and an average price of $\oiint{480}{500}$ under the hammer.

The top price of $\triangleleft 16500$ was paid by H.A. Pantall for lot n°69bis, a filly by Anabaa Blue, presented by the Haras de Saint Arnoult. The runner up price of $\triangleleft 16000$ was paid by the EURL du Chêne for Lot n°82, a colt by Saint des Saints.

The sale, supported by the customary Con Marnane, Guy Petit, H.A. Pantall, Keven Borgel, Agence FIPS, Interact, also saw new bidders such as Gina Rarick, JF Doucet, E.J. O'Neill, Charles Lecrivain as well as trainer Cédric Diard who was buying for the first time at a public auction.
